I'm writing to let you know of some essential carriageway repairs, technical surveys and routine maintenance being carried out on the A64 between Staxton and Seamer.

To protect the workforce and drivers during the works, we will need to close this section in both directions on the nights of **16, 17, 18 and 19 March 2026**.

Each closure will take place overnight (9pm-6am).

During the closures, traffic will be [diverted via the A1039 and A165](#). Local access will be maintained throughout the closures, and affected residents have been contacted directly with details of access arrangements.
